

### **Driving Offenses that Will Result in a Traffic Ticket**

- Blocking a private driveway (22500e California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236
- Parking in a red zone/fire lane (22500.1 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236
- Blocking a fire hydrant (22514 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236
- Obstructing traffic (22500g California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236
- Leaving running car unattended (10.36.909 SCC) – fine: \$236
- Leaving a child unattended in vehicle (273a Penal Code – this is a misdemeanor and can result in jail time)
- U-turn in front of a school (22103 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Driving on the sidewalk (22663 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Parking on the sidewalk (22500f California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236
- Double parking (22500h California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Impeding flow of traffic (22400a California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Failure to yield to pedestrian (21950a California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Unsafe turns (22107 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Driving on the wrong side of the street ( 21650 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Passing on the right ( 21754 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Expired registration ( 4000a California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$198
- No front license plate (5200 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$198
- Stop sign violation ( 22450 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 + 1 point
- Speeding (22350 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$236 – 470 + 1 point
- Jaywalking (21954 California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$198
- Parking in bus loading zone (22500(i) California Vehicle Code) – fine: \$1043
