OPEN ENROLLMENT

Open Enrollment is an opportunity for families that live within SCUSD boundaries to apply for spots in schools beyond their neighborhood school or to apply for enrollment in specialty programs and schools. Pony Express has 15 openings for kindergarten students. The dates for open enrollment are from February 7 starting at 8 a.m. – February 21 ending at 5 p.m. Once your child has been accepted into the school, you must register your child at the Enrollment Center to attend the new school of choice. The dates are April 3-7, 2017 & April 17-21, 2017 (closed April 10-14 for Spring Break).

Parents must indicate on the Open Enrollment application any Special Education Program Services their child is currently receiving. Students requiring special programs as a part of their Individual Educational Program (IEP) can participate in Open Enrollment based on space availability in both the required program and the school of choice. Students receiving Speech/Language Services, Resource Specialist Program (RSP) Services and students who are fully included may apply for their school of choice through Open Enrollment. Parents interested in their child attending a specific special day class (SDC) Program should contact their Program Specialist in the Special Education Department (916-643-9174).

TRAFFIC REMINDERS/STUDENT SAFETY

At drop off and pick times, we ask that you PARK your car so your child can enter and exit the car onto the sidewalk. Please do NOT double park and drop your student off behind a parked car. Please have your student walk through the crosswalk where the traffic monitor can help them safely cross the street. In the past, students have darted out into the street before we began encouraging all student to use the crosswalk at all times. It is helpful to continue driving in the direction your car is facing instead of making a U-turn in front of the school. Cones were added to prevent U-turns and this allows for a smoother traffic flow. We are working with the city to add a drop off and pick up zone in front of the school for your convenience. As a reminder, the school parking lot is for the staff to park and bus loading zone. If you do drive into the parking lot, please park your car in a parking slot. Thank you for your continued cooperation and patience. The safety of your student is Pony's number one concern.

PICKING UP STUDENTS EARLY AND CHANGING END OF DAY PICK UP PLANS

Our front office is very busy during the day supporting the daily activities that happen at school. Lately, we have been experiencing more parents picking their student up early or changing how your child will get home. We are hoping that you will make plans ahead of time before your students arrives at school. Every time we must notify your student's classroom, it interrupts learning and stops the flow during that lesson. When we have multiple requests, it becomes
