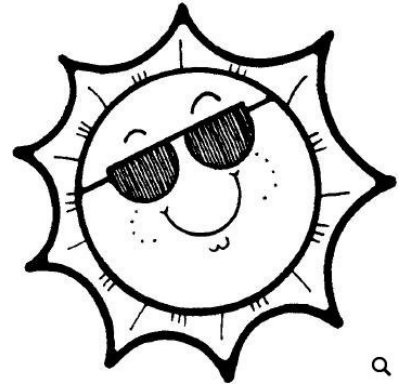


Hi Pony Community,

In lieu of having a PTA Meeting this month, I thought a flier would be faster, easier, and more convenient. I hope you agree and take a moment to read the following three points of interest:



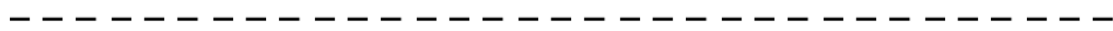
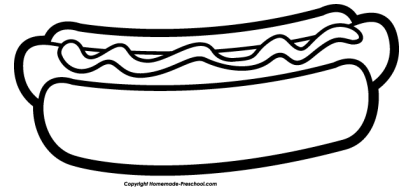
