Please have your student walk through the crosswalk where the traffic monitor can help them safely into the school. It is helpful to continue driving in the direction your car is facing instead of making a U-turn in front of the school. This will allow for a smoother traffic flow. As a reminder, the school parking lot is for the staff to park and bus loading zone. If you do drive into the parking lot, please park your car in a parking slot. Thank you for your continued cooperation and patience. The safety of your student is Pony's number one concern.
