We are also experiencing a high number of early pick-ups. I understand that doctor's appointments and emergencies do occur but, the number of early dismissals has become chronic and interrupts the learning environment at the school. Students with multiple early dismissals will be receiving a letter of concern. We must work together to ensure OUR children receive a great learning experience for the entire time they are in school. ### **Traffic Reminders**

At drop off and pick times, we ask that you PARK your car so your child can enter and exit the car onto the sidewalk. Please do NOT double park and drop your student off behind a parked car or have your child dart out into the street. Please have your student walk through the crosswalk where the traffic monitor can help them safely into the school. It is helpful to continue driving in the direction your car is facing instead of making a U-turn in front of the school. This will allow for a smoother traffic flow. As a reminder, the school parking lot is for the staff to park and bus loading zone. If you do drive into the parking lot, please park your car in a parking slot. Thank you for your continued cooperation and patience. The safety of your student is Pony's number one concern.
